2016 spring brown trout fishing was spotty, we did have some good days catching browns but

we also caught a lot of lake trout. From mid-May on, the fishing was on and off and the lake never set up right because of the high winds. In spite of that, we did have some good days on the lake for kings.

Hopefully this year will be better (but still, a bad day of fishing is better than a good day of working). The river fishing was strange this year again, with no real defined runs anywhere. However, we did get a lot of kings in the creek after Columbus Day weekend.



There were some nice 10 to 16 lb. browns caught in the creek in October. Pictured is a 20+ lb. brown caught just off our docks on November 3rd.

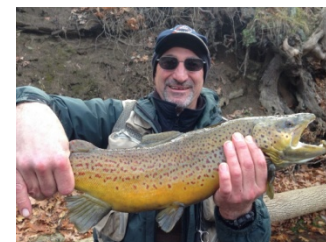
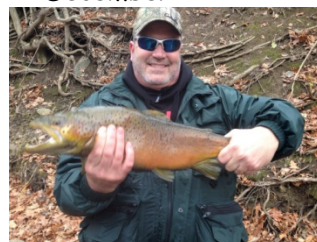
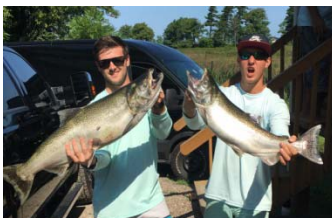
